
The Sandbox Percussion Commissioners Circle is a group of steadfast supporters who provide critical funding for the activities most central to our mission:


the creative development of new music, created by composers who represent the diverse world in which we live, that expands the breadth and depth of the percussion form.



Together with our Board of Directors, our Commissioners Circle supports dedicated time to workshop and rehearse new works.


Members help Sandbox to introduce contemporary chamber music to those who do not yet have it in their lives, building audiences for new music and educating the next generation of musicians.





The Commissioners Circle supported 13 world premieres during our 2023 – 2024 season. Highlights include:


- Our debut performance at Park Avenue Armory in NYC, featuring new work by Christopher Cerrone and Viet Cuong
- World premieres by iconic composers: John Luther Adams's Prophecies of Fire, Joan Tower's To Sing Or Dance, and Doug Cuomo's The Jump Up
- Streaming premieres by artists from our Creator Mentorship Program, which supports emerging, underrepresented composers through commissioning funds, rehearsal time, a world premiere performance, and a recording of their work
- A new album, Bloom, created with composer Michael Torke


